The government are providing support to help people with the costs of their bills.

It's important that local people know what help is available if they're struggling to meet these rising costs.

## Help for Households

Families and businesses continue to receive government support this autumn to help them manage rising costs, including heating bills.

- Households will have £400 automatically deducted from their energy bills: £66 in October and November; and £67 in each of December, January, February and March.
- The second Cost of Living instalment of £324 will be automatically paid between 8 and 23 November to millions of people who receive a qualifying benefit.
- The one-off Winter Fuel Payment will be made automatically, either this month or in December, to help pensioners.

These payments are automatic – please do not to fall for scammers who may approach you for your bank details. The DWP never asks for personal details by SMS or email.

The Help for Households site has details of a range of deals for consumers. Highlights include:

- Discounts and offers on groceries, clothes, transport, utilities and entertainment;
- Help with income support;
- Help with childcare costs;
- Help with household costs;
- Help with transport costs; and
- Help finding work.
